HOLIDAY CLUB

We are currently taking Holiday Club bookings for the May half term holiday.

HOLIDAY CLUB - SUNTAN LOTION & HATS

We like the children to be able to spend time outside and would therefore ask that you send your child to the Holiday Club with a named sun hat. We would also like to ask that sunscreen is applied before your child arrives at the Club.

We require each child to bring with them a named bottle of suntan lotion which they will be encouraged to reapply when necessary (help will be given if needed). Please be aware that if sunscreen is not provided we may have to limit the amount of time your child spends outside to protect their health.

COATS & JACKET

We ask that all children bring a coat or jacket with them when attending the Holiday Club, the weather is changeable during the day and we are only able to take the children on trips to local parks etc if they are appropriately dressed for the conditions.

SUITABLE FOOTWEAR

Please be aware that, at this time of year, the children like to spend time outside playing games and running around. With this in mind we would like to ask that the children arrive at the club wearing suitable footwear (no flip flops please).

FEE INCREASE

Our session prices will increase, in line with inflation, from September 2019;

Breakfast Club

- arriving between 7.30am and 8.00am -£4.40
- arriving after 8.00am - £3.40

After School Club

- £7.75 per session

Holiday Club

- £19.75 per session

DROPPING YOUR CHILDREN OFF

We would like to remind parents that all children being dropped off to either the breakfast club or Holiday Club sessions must be escorted to the Out of School Club room and signed in by a Parent or Carer. Children remain your responsibility until they have been signed in.

Your child's safety is paramount; we must therefore insist that this procedure is followed on all occasions.

If you have any queries regarding this please speak to Liz.

SCHOOL TRIPS AND VISITS

Please be aware that the OOSC staff are unable to drop off to, or collect your child from, anywhere outside of the school site (e.g. George Street). Parents would therefore be required to make alternative arrangements. This includes Year 6 visits to The National Academy. If you wish your child to walk up to the Academy site from the OOSC you will need to authorise this in writing giving the dates of visits, and stating that you are aware that the club is not responsible for your child after they have left the premises. We will allow children to leave at 8.20am.

IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ!

The OOSC is limited to the number of children we are able to accept to each session. If you need your child to attend an extra session, either as a one off or in an emergency, you need to contact the OOSC to check whether there is a place available.

Please do not send your child to the OOSC without contacting with Liz or Lisa at the OOSC first.

SEPTEMBER

We are currently receiving calls from parents with children starting at the school in September asking about places, if you wish to add any extra sessions or change the days/sessions your child/children come, please speak to Liz as soon as possible.

DRIVING AND PARKING IN THE SCHOOL CAR PARK

We have an agreement with school that parents of OOSC children can use the School car park before 8.00am and after 5.00pm to drop off and collect their children. A new security barrier has been installed at the entrance to the school car park. Please be aware that the barrier control is in the school office, if you press the buzzer the OOSC cannot hear it and are unable to lift the barrier to allow you to enter. Please therefore only attempt to use the car park within the times given above.

We would also like to ask that you drive slowly and with care in the car park, and park within the allocate spaces.

Please be aware that the use of the car park is a goodwill agreement between the OOSC and School which will be withdrawn if it is abused by parents.
